



Data Protection Notice for

The Blue Bioeconomy Forum first stakeholder event

7th December 2018, Amsterdam, The Netherlands

Your personal data are processed in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 45/2001¹ on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions and bodies and on the free movement of such data.

The data controller of the processing operation is the Head of Unit A3 – European Maritime Fisheries Fund of the Executive Agency for Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (EASME).

The legal basis for the processing operations are Article 5(a) of Regulation EC 45/2001 whereby processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest on the basis of the Treaties or other legal instruments adopted on the basis thereof²; Article 5(d) of Regulation EC 45/2001 based on your explicit consent for your personal data indicated below as not compulsory.

The purpose of this processing operation is to: register you as interested persons to the **The Blue Bioeconomy Forum first stakeholder event**; provide you with access to the conference venue; include you in the participants list; allow networking among the participants; allow the follow up of the event, including feedback collection and specific related communication activities; etc.

The following of your personal data are collected: your first name, last name, title, organisation, e-mail address. The above mentioned personal data are **mandatory** (except where indicated otherwise in the registration form). It is possible that **photographs** of you will be taken during the event and might be used for related communication purposes.

Upon registration, you can give your explicit consent to have your images recorded and published on any communication channel. In the absence of your consent, the organiser will find suitable alternatives, so that you can fully take part in the event, e.g. offer an

The recipients of your data will be relevant EASME and European Commission staff, involved in the organisation of the event, agents of the security personnel, TECHNOPSIS BV. and CECOFORMA, which are the contractors of the Agency in charge of organising the event, participants of the event, the public and bodies charged with monitoring or inspection tasks in application of EU law (e.g. internal audits, European Anti-fraud Office – OLAF). The participants list will be accessible on the Blue Bioeconomy Forum public website after the event, and will include the following information your first name, last name, title, organisation.

Your data will be kept for a maximum period of 6 months after the end of the event. Data will be deleted at the end of this period.

You have the right to access your personal data, to request that your personal data is, rectified and erased if your personal data is inaccurate or incomplete. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on your consent before its withdrawal..
