



## Data Protection Notice for The Blue Bioeconomy forum second stakeholder event

25<sup>th</sup> June 2019, Brussels, Belgium

**Your personal data** is processed in accordance with **Regulation (EU) No 2018/1725<sup>1</sup>** on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data.

**The data controller** of the processing operation is the Head of Unit A3 –European Maritime Fisheries Fund of the Executive Agency for Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (EASME).

**The legal basis** for the processing activities are:

- *Article 5(a) of Regulation EU 2018/1725 because processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest (or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Union institution or body)<sup>2</sup>;*
- *Article 5(d) of Regulation EU 2018/1725 based on your explicit consent for your non-mandatory personal data indicated below.*

**The purpose(s)** of this processing are to: *register and manage your participation to **The Blue Bioeconomy Forum second stakeholder event**; provide you with access to the event venue; include you in the list of participants; allow networking among participants; allow follow-up activities of the event/related to the topic of the event, including feedback collection and specific, related communication activities; etc.*

**The following of your personal data are collected:** *your first name, last name, title, function, organization, e-mail address.* This information is **mandatory** for the purpose(s) outline above.

*Please note that it is possible that **photographs** of you will be taken during the event and might be used for related communication purposes including on Internet and social media such as LinkedIn and websites like the Maritime Forum. Upon registration, you can give your explicit consent to have your images recorded and published on related communication channels<sup>7</sup>. In the absence of your consent, the organiser will try to find suitable alternatives, so that you can fully take part in the event, e.g. by offering an alternative room to follow the event.*

**The recipients** of your personal data will be **relevant EASME and European Commission staff**, involved in the organisation of the event, agents of the security personnel, **TECHNOPOLIS BV.** and **CECOFORMA**, which are the contractors of the Agency in charge of organising the event, participants of the event, the public and bodies charged with monitoring or inspection tasks in application of EU law (e.g. internal audits, Court of Auditors, European Anti-fraud Office (OLAF)). the Blue Bioeconomy Forum public website after the event and will include the following information your first name, last name, title, organisation.

Your personal data **will not be transferred** to third countries or international organisations.

The processing of your data will **not include automated decision-making** (such as profiling).

**Your personal data** will be kept for a maximum period of 6 months after the end of the event. Data will be deleted at the end of this period.

**You have the right** to access your personal data and to request your personal data to be rectified, if the data is inaccurate or incomplete; where applicable, you have the right to request restriction or to object to processing, to request a copy or erasure of your personal data held by the data controller. If processing is based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on your consent before its withdrawal.

Your request to exercise one of the above rights will be dealt with without undue delay and within **one month**.
